MESSAGE FROM HOD




WORKSHOPS

RPA Training and Development

A Training Programme on RPA development has been department of Information organized by the Technology on 15.2.2019. The workshop was handled by Mr. Paul Raj, KGiSL. RPA training platform breaks down all barriers to learning by blending all the expert knowledge and hands-on experience needed, while ena Mr. Paul Raj honored us with his presence on Friday, 15th of February, 2019 and shared his work life experiences with all Mr. Paul Raj is, Trainee RPA Team, KGiSL Pvt.Ltd, Coimbatore. The process of automating business operations with the help of robots to reduce human intervention is said to be *Robotic* Process Automation (RPA). RPA does not replace humans with actual robots. But, there are software's available in the market which let you configure automation workflows to automate your business operations. According to our experts, the demand for **RPA** certification training is going to rise by 150% due to the lack of the skill set in the market. A total of 40 participants have participated in the same. Ability to identify the different steps of an implementation, ability to choose the processes suitable for automation, ability to drive an RPA project, and raise RPA Awareness throughout the organization was the highlights of the programmed.

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Software Testing Industry Practices

The Dept. of IT organized a Guest lecture session in the subject of software testing for the Third Year students on 13th February 2018. The Resource Person was Ms. Geetha Narayanaswamy, 3rd Degree Connections, 3rd Senior Quality Assurance Lead, KGiSL Pvt.Ltd, Coimbatore. During the sessions, she explained the importance of Software testing and different types of software testing strategies. She enlightened students about the skills set required by Software Testers, the career path and also shared his personal industrial experience with the audience in automation of testing. She specially mentioned that Java and Python are the languages scripts which are in demand in the field of testing.

The workshop was held at CARE Lab, KGiSL Institute of Technology on January 29, 2019. Staff members and students were present in the lab. Ms.P.Kothai, Assistant Professor, Department of IT, KGiSL Institute of Technology, Coimbatore delivered the practice session on Basic Electrical Electronics and Measurement Engineering. The basics of electrical quantities are of particular importance - everything from electrical current, through voltage and power are all of great importance. She discussed the topic elaborately and answered the questions asked by the students. Other staff members also discussed briefly about the topic with the students. The electronics tutorials provided were expanding to cover the key basic concepts of the subject in the workshop. This workshop presented students with the basic theory and practice of electrical engineering concepts. AU Sponsored FDP on Web Technology


