Mobile Phone Service & Training

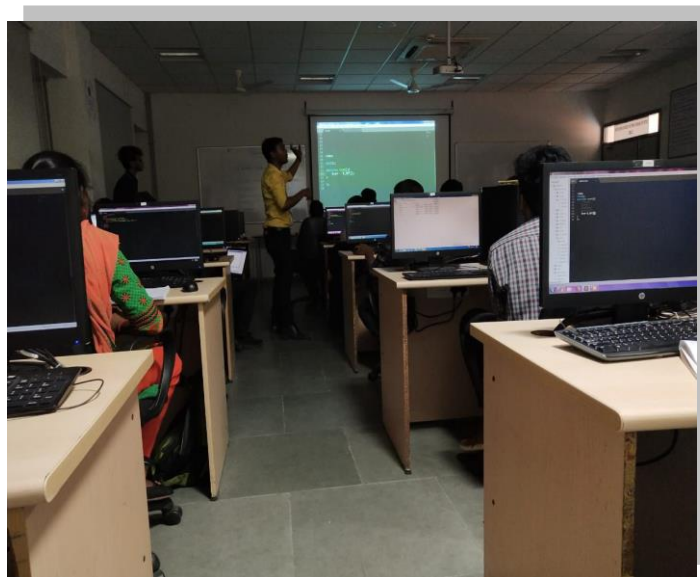
