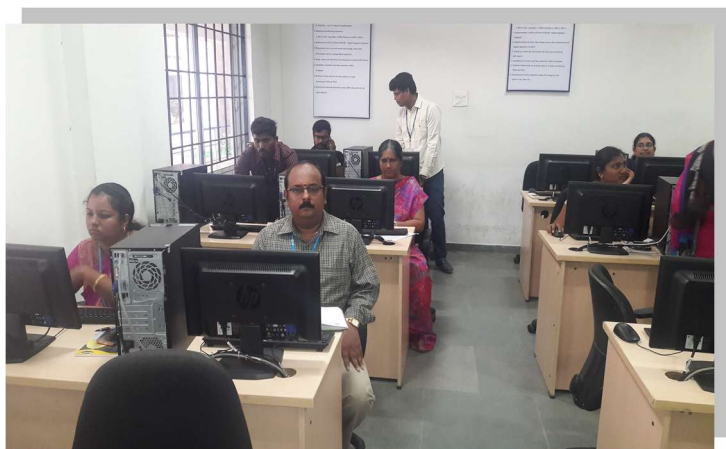
Real Time Challenges for Teachers

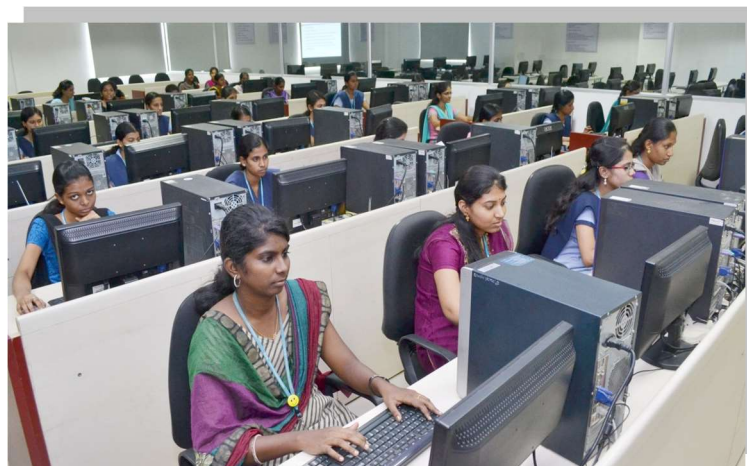
Classroom Management
