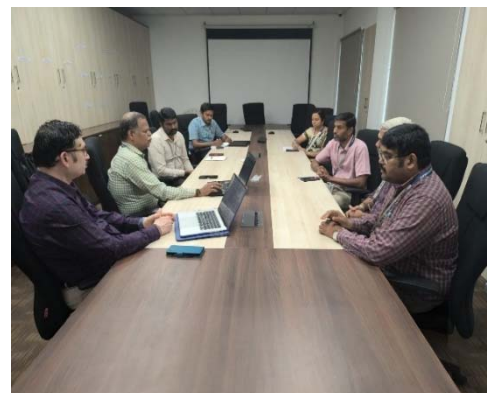
## Department Academic Advisory Committee Meeting
